

## Questions & Issues filed for the May 3, 2022 Primary Election

### **Felicity Franklin Local School District** –

Additional tax levy – 8.9 mills for-current expenses – for a continuing period of time.

### **Felicity Village** –

Renewal tax levy – 3.5 mills – for current expenses – for 5 years.

### **Franklin Township** – (entire territory includes Felicity Village)

Additional tax levy – 6 mills – for fire-EMS-police – for a continuing period of time.

### **Jackson Township** –

Replacement tax levy – 2 mills – for fire & EMS – for 5 years.

### **Williamsburg Township** – (entire territory includes Williamsburg Village)

Additional tax levy – 5 mills – for fire & EMS – for a continuing period of time.

### **Wayne Township** – (Only former Village of Newtonsville voters will vote on this question.)

Zoning Enactment Process for the former Village of Newtonsville.

### **Overlap from Clinton County**

*(subject to Clinton County Board of Elections review and certification)*

### **Blanchester Local School District** –

Annual income tax of one and one quarter percent (1.25%) on the earned income of individuals residing in the school district be imposed by Blanchester Local School District for 6 years, beginning January 1, 2023 – for current expenses and permanent improvements.

Additional tax levy – 1.75 mills – for fire & EMS – for a continuing period of time.
