Military & Overseas Absentee Voting: Begins March 17

Deadline to Register to Vote: April 3 (office open until 4:30)

Early In-Person Voting: Begins April 4 and includes the Saturday and Sunday before Election Day.

Absentee Voting By Mail: Begins April 4

Election Day: May 2 (Polls Open 6:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m.)

March 17: Military and Overseas Absentee Voting begins

April 3: Deadline to Register to Vote (office open until 4:30)

April 4: Absentee Voting by Mail begins (ends May 1)

April 4: Early In-Person Voting begins

April 25: Absentee ballot applications must be received by board of elections by 8:30 p.m.

April 30: 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

MAY

May 1: Mailed absentee ballots must be postmarked by this date.
(new earlier deadline beginning this election)

May 2: Special Election: Polls are open from 6:30 a.m. - 7:30 p.m.

May 2: Absentee Ballots May Be Returned by Mail or Personally Delivered to Your County Board of Elections. If Not Returned by Mail, Absentee Ballots Must Be Received by Your Board of Elections by 7:30 p.m.

May 6: Last day for boards to receive mail-in ballots that have been postmarked on or before May 1.
